Each country is limited to sending only two teams to participate in each category/group.

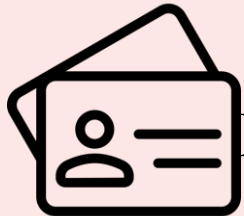

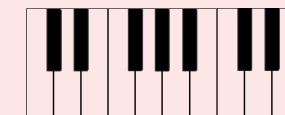

THE recently concluded JCI Elite Asia Youth Exchange Programme (AYEP) in Penang has provided a golden opportunity for youths of Asia to learn about different cultures and also to communicate with one another.

Bukit Bendera MP Wong Hon Wai, who attended the AYEY closing ceremony at the Chung Ling Private High School on July 29, said it was a good platform for the youths to mix with one another.

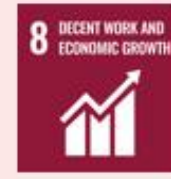
